Introduction

In India, Voluntary organizations (VOs) have played a major role in providing impetus to the developmental efforts for national building. Within NGO Management, the program will focus on record-cum-financial management, program documentation, proposal writing, as well as building perspective of the participants on Section 135 under Companies Act 2013. Information on various development schemes of the government as well private efforts will also be provided in the program.

With enhanced skills and knowledge, the VOs will be better equipped to meet the current requirements of external stakeholders, as well as in dealing with them.

This will pave way for greater collaboration of the VOs with government and corporate initiatives, contributing towards social impacts.
