### RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT



### FACILITATING A CONDUCIVE ENVIRONMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT

ISRN has been Conducting Capacity Building Programs on NGO Management to enhance the effectivity of their endeavors. In a span of five years ISRN has organised such programs in Patna, Lucknow, Mumbai, Allahabad, Bhopal, Jammu, Indore and Delhi Building capacities of 1000 VO representatives in areas such as financial management, proposal writing, CSR, documentation and communication, among others.



### RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

ISRN has been actively involved in the areas of Research with a larger aim to build a Nation where development encompasses all settings.

Accomplishing various Research Studies, ISRN has efficiently carried out Need Assessment Studies, Research study on Best CSR Practices & Baseline Study for a Village Development Program and developed a VDP on the lines of "Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojna" in collaboration with Centre for Digital Financial Inclusion (CDFI) in the districts of Mandasaur and Neemuch in Madhya Pradesh.


Furthermore, ISRN successfully executed a Need Assessment in Alwar, Rajasthan and helped in transforming the village to ODF

### REACHING OUT TO THE MEDICALLY UNDRSERVED



ISRN has been implementing a Healthcare initiative in Delhi/NCR consisting of a Mobile Health Unit (MHU) providing free of cost medical services like medicines, Lab Tests, preventive, curative and promotive counselling to the underserved community. Along the way, more than 45,000 beneficiaries from 22 slum locations have been benefitted through various such services and the numbers are ever increasing.

### MAKING A DIFFERENCE THROUGH EDUCATION

Developed India's first "Digital School Constituency (Jawad)" in Neemach, Madhya Pradesh by transforming 35 schools into "Uttam schools", ISRN has so far transformed 48 schools including schools from U.P., Haryana & M.P by incorporating Smart classrooms, Wi-Fi facilities, RO purifiers, Separate toilets for girls and boys and Solar panels through the support of Vikram Cement Works, IFFCO TOKIO Gen. Ins. Co. Ltd. and local Government funds.



### UNEARTHING THE HIDDEN TREASURES OF BEST SOCIAL PRACTICES



ISRN with the support of the Ministry of Culture has embarked on a special journey to highlight the Best Practices of the Unsung Heroes who are working silently for the Last Man under the Study titled: "Documentation and Compilation of Antyodaya based Best Practices as Propounded by Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyay". Nearly 1000 practices have been assessed on several parameters to be a part of the ambitious study.
